#### 1.0 CALL TO ORDER

Chair Sampson called a meeting of the Board of Directors of Astoria School District No. 1C, Clatsop County, to order at 5:45 P.M. on Wednesday, March 13, 2019 in the Astoria School District Boardroom.

#### 2.0 STUDENT WELLNESS SURVEY INFORMATION

Superintendent Hoppes referenced the study session agenda, introduced Mr. Andrew Fick, Astoria High School Counselor, and explained the Mr. Fick would be presenting regarding the Student Wellness Survey. Mr. Fick referenced the overhead presentation and generally discussed the survey data received from grade levels 11, 8 and 6. Mr. Fick discussed the 11<sup>th</sup> grade data and specifically explained key findings, improvements and areas of concern. There was a brief discussion regarding sample size, AHS school climate, aggressive behavior and mental health. Mrs. Rachel Rollins presented the data for grades eight and six. Mrs. Rollins discussed each topic and explained the key findings of the middle school student sample. There was discussion regarding mental health, alternate education at the middle school level, and a universal approach to attend to students' needs. Mr. Fick discussed substance abuse findings, limited resources, early intervention and ways to support our students and staff. There was a brief discussion regarding school resources and the family liaison position.

#### 3.0 HIGH SCHOOL SUCCESS (MEASURE 98) INFORMATION

Superintendent Hoppes explained that Mr. Jackson would be presenting regarding High School Success information. Mr. Jackson summarized the high school success fund distribution and referenced the overhead. Mr. Jackson briefly discussed each focus of the first biennium. He briefly discussed attendance, freshman on-track, dual enrollment with Clatsop Community College, agriculture, robotics and marine science classes. He discussed the continued allocation of funds to attendance and the addition of CTE equipment for plant sciences, and additional funds for Clatsop WORKS. There was a brief discussion regarding the partnership with Clatsop Community College.
